This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act. I request that a copy of the following documents be provided to Veterans Education Success:

- All documents the FTC possesses regarding the names of any college, university, trade school, or other institute of higher-learning that were associated with, participated in, partnered with, contracted with, or paid for services from the lead generator websites recently shut down by the FTC in the September 6, 2018 Stipulated Final Orders and discussed in Commissioner Rohit Chopra's Statement, FTC Matter/File Number: 162 3211.
- All documents the FTC possesses naming any institution of higher-learning purchasing leads in conjunction with, or otherwise participating in or financially connected to, Fanmail.com, LLC; Lon Brolliar; Andrew Dorman, and the lead generator websites they operated: www.army.com and www.army.com and www.army.com and www.army.com and www.army.com.
- All documents that the FTC possesses naming any institution of higher-learning purchasing leads related to, or otherwise participating in or financially connected to, SunKey Publishing, Inc.; Sun Key Publishing, LLC; Wheredata, LLC; Christopher Upp; Mark Van Dyke, and the lead-generator websites they operated: www.airguardenlist.com, <a href="www.

I request a waiver of all fees for this request. Disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operation of the government and is not primarily in our commercial interest as we are a nonprofit organization that advocates on behalf of veterans and their families. The information sought would illuminate which colleges were using lead generator sites that the FTC has shut down and which prompted Commissioner Chopra to state that these "[c]ompanies that prey on current and prospective service members not only harm military families, but also the broader American
