Good cause appearing, the renewed *ex parte* application of Petitioner and Plaintiff ITT Educational Services, Inc. ("ITT") for an alternative writ of mandate and an immediate stay pending determination of the merits of the petition for writ of mandate is GRANTED.

IT IS ORDERED that an alternative writ of mandate issue from this Court commanding Respondents and Defendants The California State Approving Agency for Veterans Education ("CSAAVE") and The California Department of Veterans Affairs ("CalVet") either to:

- A. immediately rescind CSAAVE's suspension of its approval of ITT's courses for enrollment by veteran students and notify the public that ITT's courses are

approved for enrollment by veteran students; or

B. in the alternative, show cause before this Court on August 21, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. why CSAAVE and CalVet have not done so.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the merits of ITT's petition for a peremptory writ of mandate shall be heard on August 21, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. CSAAVE and CalVet shall file its opposition papers, if any, to ITT's petition for writ of mandate by July 17, 2015. ITT shall file its reply papers, if any, in support of its petition for writ of mandate by August 7, 2015.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the decision of Respondent and Defendant The California State Approving Agency for Veterans Education ("CSAAVE"), a division of Respondent and Defendant The California Department of Veterans Affairs ("CalVet"), suspending CSAAVE's approval of ITT's courses for enrollment by veteran students is hereby STAYED, pending the Court's adjudication of ITT's petition for peremptory writ of mandate. While this stay is in effect, CSAAVE's suspension of ITT's courses for enrollment by veteran students is lifted. CSAAVE and CalVet shall not issue any further notice to ITT's veteran students about the suspension, and CSAAVE and CalVet shall notify the public of the lifting of the suspension.

This Stay Order shall expire on August 21, 2015.
