




NASAA FY 19 Cooperative Agreement and Funding Formula




Q12 The VA has added a requirement for FY 19 that their federal background investigation not only be initiated (which is the current req't) but also completed before an employee can work on and be paid on the contract. For example, if you had a new hire on October 1 who completed their fingerprints and all the forms and submitted them to VA same day, that person could not begin work until a favorable clearance is received back from VA. From what we have gathered, this process generally takes one to two months (sometimes less, sometimes more). Please note that


