

Dear GI Bill® Student,

On February 27, 2019, the U.S. Department of Education (ED) officially notified Dream Center Education Holdings, owners of The Art Institute and Argosy University, that its participation in Federal Student Aid programs has ended. Dream Center Education Holdings has until March 11, 2019, to provide ED with evidence to dispute their decision.

What Does This Mean for You as a Student?

This action does not affect your GI Bill payments. However, we are monitoring the status of the affected schools and will keep you informed of any changes.
